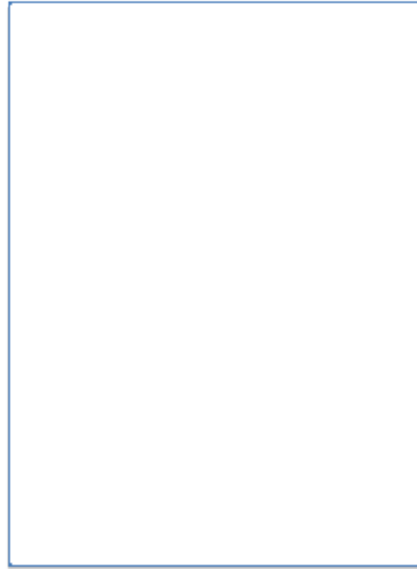


Step 1:

Draw lightly, a rough sketch of the outside of the nose.
Remember, noses are hard to draw because there are real defining lines.

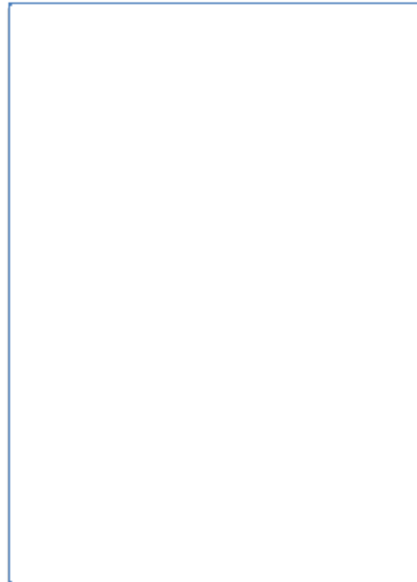

Step 2:

Add a subtle shading of the nostril area as well as a small line showing where a imaginary line would continue.

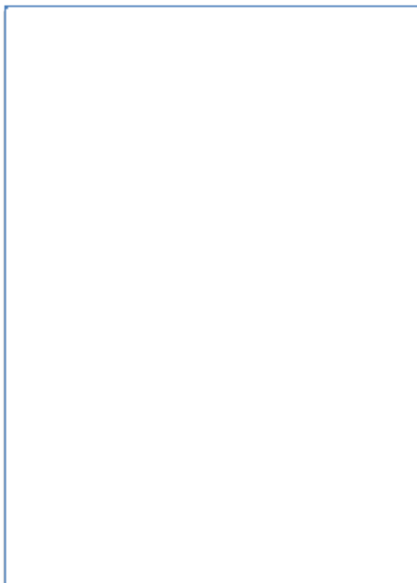

Step 3:

This shows where the light source comes in and how it affects the shadow on the face.
Draw the shadow on the side opposite of the light coming in as shown in the image.

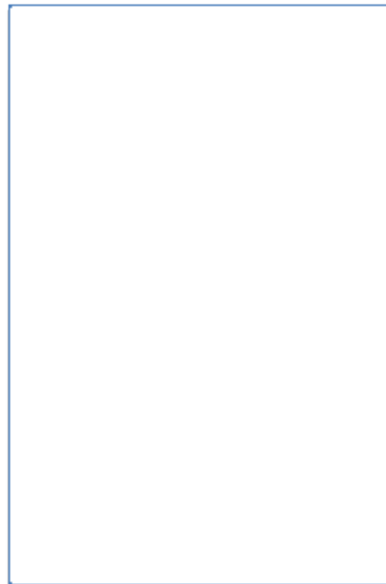

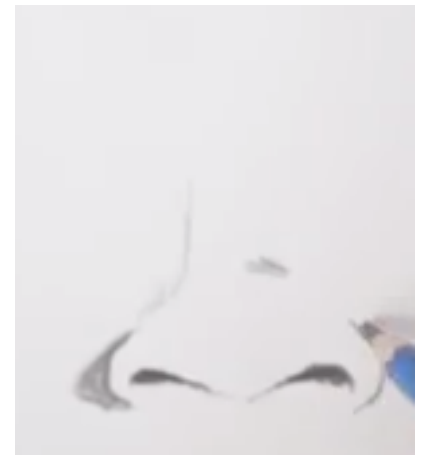


Step 4:

Continue to add details, including the line continuing up the nose to give it definition.

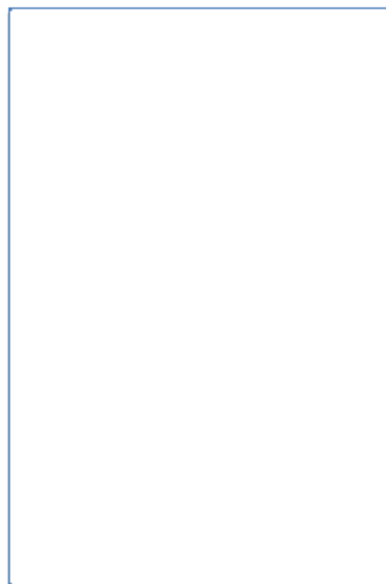

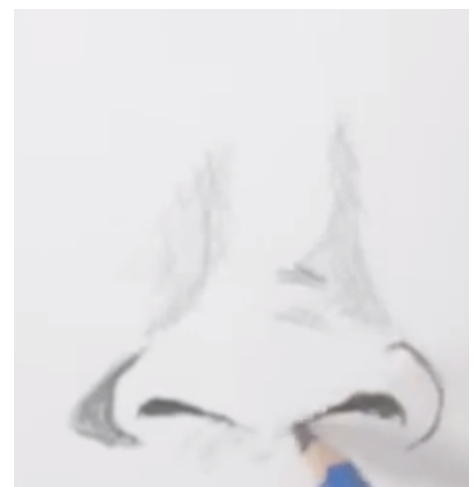


Step 5:

Add light shadows on both sides of the nose as well as a very light line connecting the shadow in the nostrils.

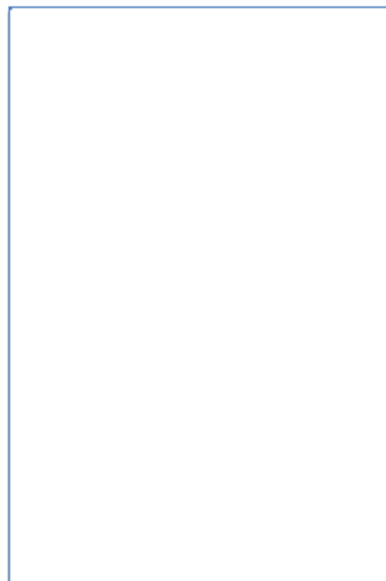

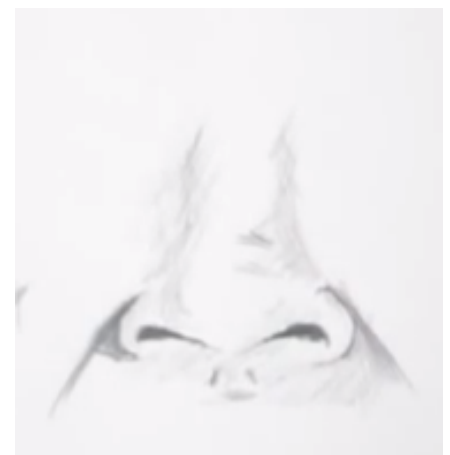


Step 6:

Add continued lines from the corners of the nose going out. These are where wrinkles form from smiling so much.

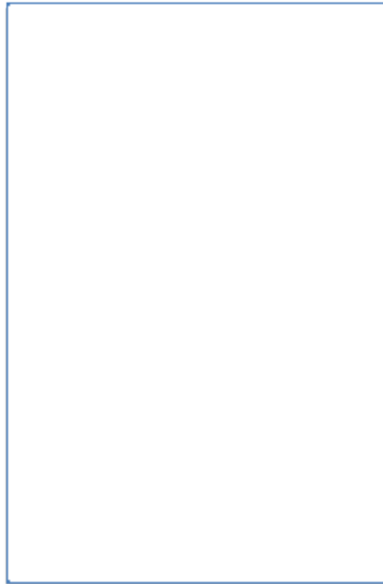

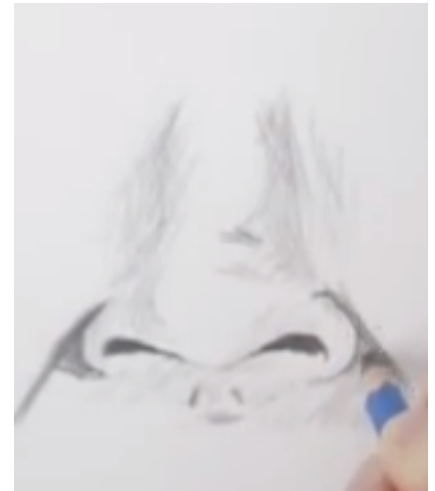


Step 7:

Add shadows next to the nose and fill in the upper lip lines.



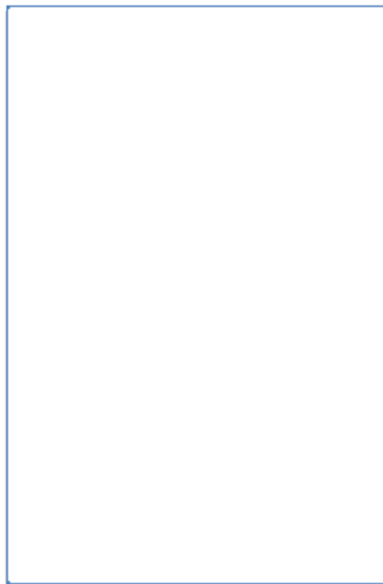

Step 8:

Round out the tip of the nose with a very light circle.

Add final details by making shadows darker or lighter and any adjustments.
